

## COVID-19 Procedure for CanSkate Tofield Skating Club

### 1. Health Check & Contact Tracing:

Families will be sent an online health questionnaire that must be completed within 3 hours of the scheduled activity. This questionnaire will include contact tracing for the skater and all members accompanying the skater. Please do not enter the arena until this is completed.

### 2. Masks:

Masks are mandatory for everyone entering the arena. Skaters may remove their masks when helmets go on.

### 3. Arrival:

Skaters should arrive at the arena, through the players entrance doors on the south side of the building, fully dressed for the activity, and no more than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled skating time. The main entrance doors will remain locked. Benches in the hallway are for tying skates and putting helmets on only.

### 4. Check In:

Upon arrival, families need to check in with a club administrator to confirm verbally that their health check and contact tracing has been completed. Skaters who have not checked in cannot step on the ice.

### 5. Skate Tying & Helmets:

After checking in, skaters will proceed to the marked seating spaces on the benches on the west end of the hallway to tie skates and put helmets on. Skaters will remain seated until a coach or program assistant collects them.

6. Ice Entry:

Cankaters will enter and exit the ice through the gates on the west end of the arena. A coach or program assistant will lead the skaters to the ice.

7. Supervision of Children:

All children not on the ice must remain seated with their parents in the stands. They may not be allowed to roam the facility unsupervised. If a skater needs to leave the ice for any reason, they must be accompanied by a parent or cohort member.

8. Departure:

Families must leave the facility within 15 minutes of the end of the activity.
